



2019 December Vacation Program

The Community Services and Parks Department, Recreation Division will be offering six days of trips and activities for area children during the December Vacation week. Children may either sign up for a whole day of activities or simply a trip or a project. Registration is limited to East Greenwich residential taxpayers. Activities and trips have a limited enrollment.

Registration begins on Monday, November 25, 2019

ONLINE REGISTRATION: EG Residents may sign up online for these activities as long as they have a pre-approved online account. To get a pre -approved account, submit an online account request form to the office ahead of time. (Forms can be printed off the Town web site at www.eastgreenwichri.com.) Once verified you will receive an email with your password. If you need to set up your account, then act immediately so on the first day of sign-ups you are ready to go!

Already have an account and password, then you are all set to sign up on 11/25/19 at 8:45am by logging on to www.eastgreenwichri.com. *If you need to update your list of pick-up & release people or update any medical information you will need to stop at the office and fill out a change of information form. This cannot be done online.*

PAPER REGISTRATION forms are still accepted by mail or in person. Simply get your form to the office before the first day of registration and we will begin enrolling it lottery style on 11/25/19. Your best chance of getting your selection will be via the online process as classes will fill on a first come basis and the office can only process forms one at a time. One form per child and one envelope per family please.

A computer print-out will acknowledge receipt of your form. If you do not receive one then call us. All late walk-in registrations will begin on Tuesday, November 26, 2019.

REFUNDS: NO refunds will be given after **12/13/19** unless the activity is canceled. If you or your child becomes injured, ill, unavailable, disinterested, etc. after this date and your spot can be filled with someone on our wait list then you may receive a partial refund. Please notify the office as soon as possible so that we can attempt to reach someone.

CAMPERSHIPS will be provided to those on public assistance. Please submit your registration form to the office before the 1st registration day along with proof of need (ie. housing statement, SNAP card, SSI documentation, etc.)

CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED: All credit card transactions will be charged a processing fee and are billed directly to your credit card. The processing fee is 2.5% of the total charge or a minimum of \$1.95. Processing fees are not refundable.

Monday, December 23, 2019

Boss Ice Arena: Take a trip to Boss Ice Arena for ice skating. The group will have the ice to themselves. Bring your own skates if you have them. Children will be able to rent skates for \$5 at the rink if they do not have their own.

Roger Williams Zoo: Let's visit the animals in the colder weather. See the giraffes, the elephants, bears, and penguins. Wear sneakers or boots, a jacket, hat and mittens.

Tuesday, December 24, 2019

Gingerbread Houses: Join the Parks and Recreation Department in building, designing and decorating your own unique gingerbread houses. Come prepared with a creative idea and enjoy the winter fun with some hot chocolate.

Thursday, December 26, 2019

Wild Animals: Travel to Artists' Exchange and pick your own animal to decorate, clothe, assemble, stuff and seal. Participants will be responsible for the entire process from start to finish and get to make it their very own creation to bring home.

Movies: This afternoon we're off to the movies. The movie and time are based on the showtimes. Sign up now and the office will call and confirm the movie times once it is finalized. Children may bring extra money for snacks.

Friday, December 27, 2019

Yale Peabody Museum: Join us for a tour of Yale University's museum. A guided program on dinosaurs will take place with their docent, followed by time to explore the museum in small groups. Bring a bag lunch and drink.

Monday, December 30, 2019

Duckpin Bowling: Hit the lanes at Legion Bowl in Cranston and knock down the pins. Try your luck at knocking down the pins with a smaller bowling ball. Participants must wear socks and sneakers.

5 Wits: This morning we head out for an undercover mission at Patriot Place's 5 Wits. The group will work as a team to try and solve a challenge that lay before them using hands-on, interactive, walk through puzzles that once solved open up a clue to solve the mission. The interactive themed rooms are somewhat realistic, so could be too intense for younger folks who aren't comfortable with mild special effects. Participants must wear sneakers.

Tuesday, December 31, 2019

New Year's Eve Bash: We celebrate a little early with a kid friendly countdown at the Parks & Recreation Program room! Each half hour there will be a different activity until the clock strikes "midnight" and the party begins! Come dressed for crafts, games and food!

EXTENDED DAY OPTION-Fee: \$10/day (M, W, Th, F) & \$5/day (T 12/24 & T 12/31)

The Parks & Recreation Office at 1127 Frenchtown Road will be open at 8:30am and close at 5:00pm for those children needing a longer day. On Tuesday, December 24 & Tuesday, December 31, the office will be open at 8:30am and close at 11:45am. Children can come in early, stay through lunch and the break period, and stay late by signing up for the Extended Day. **If you're just staying between the two activities, then you must also sign up for the Extended Day Option.** Children are to be dropped off at the office after 8:30am and before the 1st trip time. The fee includes supervision before and after the trip or slated activity as well as opportunities to do crafts, play games, play outdoors, etc. and an afternoon snack. Children must pay and sign up for the above list of events. NO alternative activities are planned. Please dress your children for outdoor play (jackets, sneakers). Children must bring a bag lunch & drink each day.

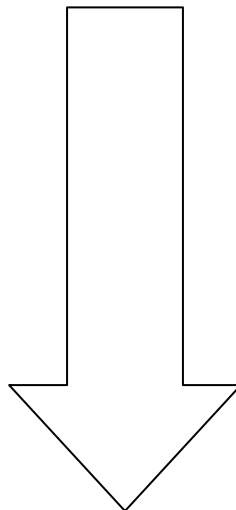
HOW TO SIGN UP ON-LINE FOR EXTENDED DAY: When registering yourself on-line you will be prompted to sign up for the Extended Day Option when signing up for the afternoon activity. You should click "yes" if you have registered for that morning's activity and will be dropping off at 8:30am and/or picking up no later than 5:00pm ; or staying in between activities on the same day. If one of the two activities on the same day is full, then you cannot stay for the whole day. Contact the office for some options to participate for a portion of the day.
