



2020 February Vacation Program

The Community Services and Parks Department, Recreation Division will be offering four days of trips and activities for children during the February Vacation week. Children may either sign up for a whole day of activities or simply a trip or a project. Registration is limited to East Greenwich residential taxpayers. Activities and trips have a limited enrollment.

Registration begins on Tuesday, January 21, 2020

ONLINE REGISTRATION: EG Residents may sign up online for these activities as long as they have a preapproved online account. To get a pre-approved account, submit an account request form to the office ahead of time. (Forms can be printed off the Town web site at www.eastgreenwichri.com.) Once verified you will receive an email with your password. If you need to set up your account, then act immediately so on the first day of sign-ups you are ready to go!

Already have an account and password, then you are all set to sign up on 1/21/20 at 8:45am by logging on to www.eastgreenwichri.com. *If you need to update your list of pick-up & release people or update any medical information you will need to stop at the office and fill out a change of information form. This cannot be done online.*

PAPER REGISTRATION forms are still accepted by mail or in person. Simply get your form to the office by the first day of registration and we will begin enrolling it lottery style on 1/21/20. Your best chance of getting your selection will be via the online process as classes will fill on a first come basis and the office can only process forms one at a time. One form per child and one envelope per family please.

A computer print-out will acknowledge receipt of your form. If you do not receive one then call us. All late walk-in registrations will begin on Wed, Jan. 22, 2020.

REFUNDS: NO refunds will be given after **2/10/20**, unless the activity is canceled. If you or your child becomes injured, ill, unavailable, disinterested, etc. after this date and your spot can be filled with someone on our waitlist then you may receive a partial refund. Please notify the office as soon as possible so that we can attempt to reach someone.

CAMPERSHIPS will be provided to those on public assistance. Please submit your registration form to the office before the 1st registration day along with proof of need (ie. housing statement, SNAP card, SSI documentation, etc.)

CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED: All credit card transactions will be charged a processing fee and are billed directly to your credit card. The processing fee is 2.5% of the total charge or a minimum of \$1.95. Processing fees are not refundable.

POW! Science: This morning's workshop takes place at POW! Science. The group will participate in the Dynamic Earth program. Earthquakes, tornadoes, volcanic eruptions! Kids model and demonstrate the phenomena that shape our ever-changing planet. The earthquake experiment uses a Milky Way candy bar. Notify the office of all allergies. Wear clothes to experiment in.

Central Rock Gym: Join us for a trip to this Warwick indoor rock climbing gym. Learn how to climb as the instructors belay you. *A Central Rock Gym waiver is required and can be completed on the rock gym website (centralrockgym.com/warwick) or signed at the Recreation office before the day of the trip.* Wear gym clothes, socks and sneakers.

Thursday, February 20, 2020

Ninja Training at Aim High: Spend the morning practicing your Ninja skills. Run, jump, tumble, and climb your way through the gym, while building strength, coordination and confidence. Participants must wear socks and gym clothes. Bring a water bottle. *An Aim High waiver is required to participate and must be submitted to the office before the day of the trip.*

Monster Mini Golf: Join us for a round of mini golf at this Seekonk indoor course. There are friendly glow in the dark monsters throughout the course. We will not use the arcade this time.

Friday, February 21, 2020

Rainforest Reptiles: Today the group is visited by the Roger Williams Park Zoo, who will make a presentation on Rainforest Reptiles. Participants will explore the four layers of the rainforest and the structural adaptations that help animals survive in each. Animal ambassadors will accompany the presentation. Rollerskating: It's time to lace up your skates and move to the music at United Skates. The price includes regular skate rental. Bring extra money for the snack bar, if you wish. Please wear gym type clothes and socks. (Roller blade rental available -extra \$5 -paid at the rink.)

EXTENDED DAY OPTION-Fee: \$10.00/ day (T, W, Th, F)

The Recreation Office at 1127 Frenchtown Road will be open at 8:30am and close at 5:00pm for those children needing a longer day. Children can come in early, stay through lunch and the break period, and stay late by signing up for the Extended Day. **If you're just staying between the two activities, then you must also sign up for the Extended Day Option.** Children are to be dropped off at the office after 8:30am and before the 1st trip time. The fee includes supervision before and after the trip or slated activity as well as opportunities to do crafts, play games, play outdoors, etc. and an afternoon snack. Children must pay and sign up for the above list of events. NO alternative activities are planned. Please dress your children for outdoor play (jackets, boots, mittens, etc.). Children must bring a bag lunch & drink each day.

HOW TO SIGN UP ON-LINE FOR EXTENDED DAY: When registering yourself on-line you will be prompted to sign up for the Extended Day Option when signing up for the afternoon activity. You should click "yes" if you have registered for that morning's activity and will be dropping off at 8:30am and/or picking up no later than 5:00pm ; or staying in between activities on the same day. If one of the two activities on the same day is full, then you cannot stay for the whole day. Contact the office for some options to participate for a portion of the day.
