A

- Appliances (large/white goods): free pickup curbside, on a monthly basis, by calling the DPW office for an appointment OR drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Appliances (w/ Freon): free pickup curbside, on a monthly basis, by calling the DPW office at 886-8620 or 886-8621 for an appointment.

B

- Books, CDs, DVDs: Collection bins
 - Readingtree.org (discoverbooks.com) (private-not related to readingtree.org website)

- Bulky Waste: Free pickup curbside for bulky items, limit one item per week. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station.

- Carpeting/Rugs: Free pickup curbside for bulky items, limit one item per week. Cut into manageable pieces. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Christmas Trees: Place curbside on your regular collection day during the scheduled weeks of January (see Collection Calendar on the DPW's website for the schedule), or drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Clothes, Shoes, Clean and dry Textiles (sheets, towels, rags, etc):

- E-waste: Drop off at Office Recycling Solutions, 65 Rocky Hollow Road, East Greenwich, Mon - Fri, 7:30AM to 3:30PM. 401-580-7882 Accepts: TVs, CRT Monitors, CPUs and all other items such as printers, ink cartridges, wire and cable, UPSs, and more.
- Extra Recycling: Drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Eyeglasses: Lions Club collection bin, Felicia’s Coffee, 5757 Post Road

F

- Furniture, Appliances, Construction Materials (Paint, Lumber, Hardware, etc)
 - Truck will pick up large donations: ReStore, 1555 Shannock Road, Charlestown – non-profit
 - Habitat for Humanity – <http://restoreri.org/donate> call (401) 213-6716
- Furniture, unusable: Free pickup curbside for bulky items, limit one item per week. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station.

I

- Ink Cartridges: Drop off at Office Recycling Solutions, 65 Rocky Hollow Road, East Greenwich, Mon - Fri, 7:30AM to 3:30PM. Accepts: TVs, CRT Monitors, CPUs and all other items such as printers, ink cartridges, wire and cable, UPSs, and more.

L

- Leaves & Yard Waste: Place curbside on your regular collection day during April, May, October, November, and every other week June-September (see Solid Waste/Recycling Calendar for schedule) OR drop off at the Transfer Station.

M

- Mattresses & Box Springs: Drop off at Transfer Station OR free pickup curbside for bulky items, limit one item per week. Place next to trash barrel.
- Medications: MedReturn bin at Police Station, 176 First Avenue
- Motor Oil & Filters: Drop off at the Transfer Station.

P

- Paper for Shredding: Free at yearly town event, usually in conjunction with the yearly EcoDepot hazardous waste day. Call DPW for updates.
- Plastic Pots for Plants: collection bin
 - Wildwood Nursery and Garden Center, 659 Frenchtown Road

R

- Rechargeable Batteries and Cellphones: collection bins
 - Salks Ace Hardware, 5941 Post Road, North Kingstown
 - Lowe's, 510 Quaker Lane, Warwick

S

- Scrap Metal: Free pickup curbside for bulky items, one per month. Call DPW for appointment. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station. Items like lawn mowers must have the fluids drained.
- Styrofoam Packing "Peanuts": UPS Store, 5600 Post Road (Benny's Plaza)
- Styrofoam blocks, food containers, cups (clean and dry): bin at EcoDepot
